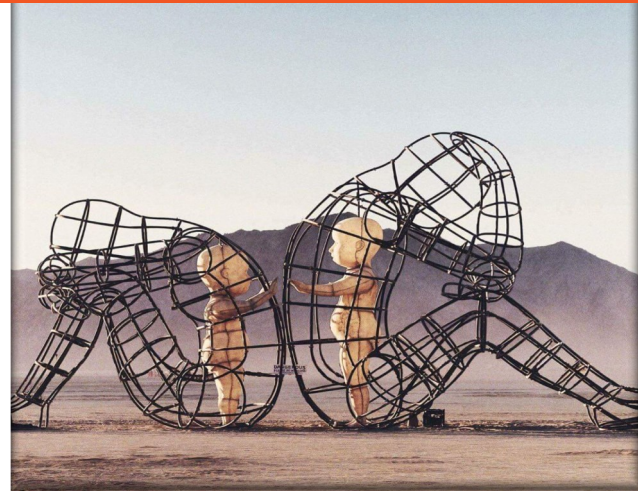


Trauma Informed Practice
