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Understanding the Impact of Domestic Violence on Children

Research indicates an alarming prevalence of domestic violence in our society and a potentially harmful impact on children. For these reasons it is important for those workers who encounter children in their work roles to have some insight into domestic violence and its impact on children.

- How workers can support vulnerable children where domestic violence has been an experience.

She has worked in a range of capacities primarily with survivors of domestic violence and sexual abuse, both adults and children. She has a practice in Sydney where the focus of her clinical work is with survivors of domestic violence and child abuse, as well as supervision of counsellors and caseworkers working in trauma and child protection fields.
