

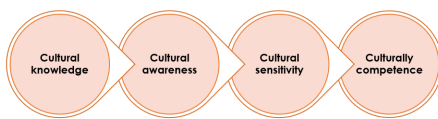

Are you 'Culturally Competent' to work with
Aboriginal families and your Aboriginal colleagues?



This one day face to face workshop will help you navigate the levels of cultural competency. It has been designed to equip you with strategies and strengthen your practice skills to build effective working relationships with Aboriginal clients and colleagues. You will explore the key themes and capabilities of cultural competency and understand how culturally appropriate policies and procedures can be embedded in your organisational culture.

Learning Outcomes:

- ⇒ Understand the difference between being culturally aware, culturally competent and culturally safe;
- ⇒ Apply knowledge of the intersection of cultural safety and trauma informed practice when it comes to providing culturally safe services, and
- ⇒ Demonstrate increased confidence, skills, and capacity to be proactive in using work practices that reflect cultural competency.

Facilitator: Sigrid Herring has more than 25 years' experience developing, implementing and managing community-based services and projects for families, community groups, children and young people. Sigrid has also over 20 years' experience training community and workforce groups in family violence, sexual violence, child protection, case management, working with adult survivors, and working with Aboriginal families and communities.
